### **EXTEMP SPEECH STRUCTURE**

#### I. INTRODUCTION

- **A.** Attention getter. This can be an anecdote or a quotation. If it's an anecdote, there should be a CLEAR analogy to the topic.
- B. Explain the link of your anecdote or quote to the topic.
- **C.** Explain the significance of the topic.
- D. Read your question WORD FOR WORD as it was written.
- E. Answer the question and say what your two (or three) areas of analysis will be.

#### II. BODY

- A. Area of Analysis 1
  - **1.** Generalization 1
    - a. Documentation/evidence
    - b. Documentation/evidence
  - 2. Generalization 2
    - **a.** Documentation/evidence

- **C.** Tie your ending into your attention getter.
- TIPS: ANSWER the question RELATE it to your audience Be ORGANIZED Be CLEAR Be CURRENT
